

<u>Teacher Assessed Grades – Subject evidence</u>

Please find below the range of evidence that will be used by each subject to determine the teacher assessed grade (TAG) for each student. The grades issued by the teachers will not take account of a student's potential. They will be a snapshot of the standard the student is performing at based on the wide range of evidence collected.

Content covered by evidence: The vast majority of the evidence used to assist staff with assessing grades, will consist of course material covered when the students have been in school. On the rare occasion an assessment completed during home learning (an 'online assessment') is used as evidence these tests will have a lighter weighting when contributing to the overall TAG than those assessments covering content studied in school.

Missing evidence: Where the evidence below is not available for a student, e.g. a missing assessment due to a Covid related absence, teachers will complete a 'variations for individual students' form to indicate the absence of a piece of evidence and/or the evidence used instead.

Access arrangements: Students who have exam access arrangements should have had these in place for their assessments. Where this was not possible teachers have completed a 'variations for individual students' form so that this is taken into account when determining a TAG. Access arrangements are in place for all of the standardised assessments.

Special consideration: Requests will not apply in the usual way this summer because students are not taking exams. If you think that your performance in an assessment has been affected by illness or personal circumstances please contact Miss Desbottes as soon as possible. It is important that you raise any such instances before we submit student grades.

Standardised assessments: Wherever possible staff have used materials provided by the exam boards and they will be marked in accordance with the exam board mark schemes and moderated either within the school or externally with other schools. Standardised assessments are not used where the qualification is 100% coursework based.

Teacher assessed grade review: Once a teacher has determined a student's grade it will be reviewed by subject leads who will ensure that all teachers have made consistent judgements in deriving a grade. Two designated staff members, Mr Nicholson and Miss Desbottes will then carry out quality assurance of the final teacher assessed grades after they have been passed by SLT member working with each subject. This follows the JCQ Policy on assessing grades.

Once you have reviewed the evidence being used parents and students will be asked to sign the 'candidate confirmation document' to confirm that they have understood the process by which the teacher assessed grades will be awarded this year. Please return the form to school by the 21st May 2021.

If you have any concerns or questions regarding the evidence used or any part of the grading process please contact Miss Desbottes as soon as possible to discuss. It is important that these are resolved before the teacher assessed grades are submitted.
